ACT I: ARRIVAL IN SUNNY SAN DIEGO

Your San Diego adventure begins here! Once you've collected your luggage, finding your onward transportation is a breeze.

Need a Ride Right Away?

Look for the clearly marked Taxis & Rideshares (Uber/Lyft) pick-up zones just outside baggage claim. Most services offer wheelchairaccessible vehicles - simply request this when booking through the app or by contacting the company.





Travel Time: 18-25 minutes (considering traffic)

Visual Cue: Look out for the designated taxi and rideshare pickup signs.



San Diego's Metropolitan Transit System (MTS) https://www.sdmts.com/ is a convenient and accessible option.

The 992 Bus: This route offers a direct connection to Downtown San Diego, a major hub for transfers. Follow the **"MTS" bus stop signs**.

Connecting to the Trolley: For easy access to SDSU and other parts of the city, hop on the free "Flyer" shuttle to the Old Town Transit Center. From there, the Trolley awaits! Its level platforms and designated wheelchair spaces make it a comfortable ride.



PREFER YOUR OWN WHEELS?

Numerous Rental Car agencies are located at the airport. Remember to book your accessible vehicle well in advance to ensure it's ready for you.

CURTAIN CALL FOR SAN

Navigating the airport is designed for ease. Look for the universal accessibility symbols for restrooms and other accessible facilities. Wheelchair assistance is available – just request it from your airline or the Airport Authority beforehand.





Whether you're staying here or just passing through, South Campus Plaza is a key location.

FROM SAN BY CAR (APPROX. 20-30 MINUTES):

A straightforward drive via CA-163 N and I-8 E will bring you right to College Avenue. South Campus Plaza will be on your left.

FROM SAN BY PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION (APPROX. 1 HOUR):

The scenic route via the 992 bus and the Green Line Trolley drops you right at the SDSU Station, a short stroll from South Campus Plaza.



STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE:

- Take the San Diego Flyer: Upon arriving at the airport, take the free San Diego Flyer shuttle to Old Town Transit Center. The shuttle runs 7 days a week, with pick-ups every 20-30 minutes.
- Transfer to the Trolley: At Old Town Transit Center, board the MTS Trolley Green Line heading towards El Cajon.
- Reach SDSU Transit Center: Stay on the trolley until you reach the SDSU Transit Center stop.

From South Campus Plaza by Foot (approx. 5-8 minutes):

Enjoy a pleasant walk north on.

South Campus Plaza Parking is available at Lot 3 or you can park at Lot 12, which is closest to the Theater Dept. It is paid parking. You have an option of paying hourly (up to 5 hours) or 24-hour total. You can pay by phone or pay when you arrive at the pay-station kiosk on level 8. The Pay-station kiosk offers 5-10 hours for \$15 or overnight for \$25.


FINDING YOUR SEAT:

A Step-by-Step Guide to the Main Stage Theatre

Ready for the show? Getting from the parking lot to the Main Stage Theatre is a breeze! We've mapped out the clearest path to ensure you find your seat with ease and confidence. Follow these simple steps, and you'll be ready for all the conference action.



Locate Parking Structure 12 at SDSU (Aztec Bowl, San Diego, CA 92182)








Here are the elevators.

Take them to the top floor, level 8.






Here is the top of the parking structure.

You will see the Main Stage Theatre on your left after you walk on campus a bit farther.

Accessibility at the Theatre:

The Main Stage Theatre is a fully accessible building.







Located within South Campus Plaza

Ready to connect and relax after a stimulating day? Eureka! is a conveniently located restaurant and bar right next to the South Campus Plaza.

From South Campus Plaza by Walking (approx. 2 minutes): It's just a short stroll within the plaza itself.

From the Main Theatre by Foot (approx. 5-8 minutes):

Head south, making your way back towards College Ave and South Campus Plaza. Keep an eye out for campus signage.

Navigating Back:

If you're at the Main Theatre and heading to Eureka!, walking south along the main pedestrian walkways towards College Avenue is usually the most direct and scenic route.

For those opting for this accommodation:

To SDSU (South Campus Plaza) by Car (approx. 10-15 minutes):

 A straightforward drive east on Rio San Diego Dr and onto I-8 E.

To SDSU (South Campus Plaza) by Public Transportation (approx. 10 minutes, but could be a 15 min wait for the train, schedule here):

 The Green Line Trolley headed East toward El Cajon from the nearby Rio Vista Station will take you to SDSU South Plaza. (5 stops)

Connecting to San Diego via CBX
The <u>Cross Border Xpress (CBX)</u> is often
the most seamless way to cross. This
pedestrian bridge directly links the
Tijuana Airport to a U.S. terminal in San
Diego (Otay Mesa).*

Whether you're arriving in the US or heading to Tijuana, CBX is designed for accessible passage. Look for ramps and elevators. (For more information, visit: https://www.crossborderxpress.com/en/assisted-pass/ or contact your airline in advance to request wheelchair or mobility assistance at the Tijuana International Airport.)

Other Ground Transportation: Taxis, ride-shares like Uber, and private shuttles are available on the Mexican side. Always agree on the fare beforehand. Inquire about accessible options directly with the service.

*The Otay Mesa port of entry is only for individuals flying to Tijuana Airport and crossing into San Diego. For those crossing from SDSU to CECUT or vice versa, the San Ysidro/Punto de Internacion Puerta Este en la Puerta Mexico de Tijuana port of entry will be used.



Our central location for the Tijuana portion of the conference is only about 8 mins from the border.

Getting There:

Conference Shuttle Bus (Pre-Selected Option):

A dedicated shuttle will be available for attendees who indicated their interest in the conference-provided transportation. Please ensure you have selected this option during registration to secure your spot. The accessibility features of the shuttle will be communicated separately.

Trolley to Border & Walk:

- Catch the Green Line Trolley to 12th & Imperial. Switch to the Blue Line Trolley towards San Ysidro. https://www.sdmts.com/transitservices/trolley
- After exiting, you'll walk across the border and can find taxis or rideshares like Uber on the Mexican side.

Taxis & Rideshares:

 Widely available in Tijuana. Agree on the fare before your ride. Accessible options may be less common, so it's best to inquire directly.

From SDSU (South Campus Plaza) by Public Transportation (approx. 40-50 minutes):

Catch the 11 Bus on Montezuma Rd & College Ave. Exit Park Bl & University Ave. Switch to the 7 Bus toward Downtown and exit Park Bl & Village Pl. (Note: this will involve about 10 minutes of walking.) (total travel time: 52 minutes* dependent on traffic)




PARKING

Parking Website

Parking can fill up at Balboa Park. The largest parking lot is behind the Organ Pavilion, which is about a 5-8 min walk to the theatre. There is also a trolley to help transport people throughout the park. For those with a handicap placard, there is a smaller parking lot with multiple handicap spots by the Alcazar Garden. Then you walk through the garden and cross the street to get to The Old Globe

Making it Easier: For convenient access, a designated drop-off zone for attendees with accessibility needs is available on Old Globe Way, next to The Old Globe. See photo below.
